



Mixed Moves



Mortgage rates edged higher this week, rising from 6.29% to 6.35%. The Fed cut its benchmark rate by 25 basis points, but markets had already priced it in, so mortgage rates failed to follow lower. Instead, bond yields climbed on the Fed's concerns about 2026, leaving rates slightly elevated by week's end.

Mortgage rates edged up to 6.35% this week from 6.29%. The Fed cut its benchmark rate by 25 bps, but since markets had already priced it in, mortgage rates didn't move lower. Bond yields climbed on the Fed's outlook for 2026, keeping rates slightly higher by week's end.
